FORFEITS, CANCELLED & RESCHEDULED GAMES

COACHES DO NOT CONTACT YOUR OPPONENT DIRECTLY TO CANCEL OR RESCHEDULE ANY GAME(S) UNTIL YOU HAVE FIRST CONTACTED YOUR LEAGUE COMMISSIONER.

Any team that cannot play a posted game has two options:

Option #1 – If a team cannot play a game that is posted on their League Schedule they can cancel the game by contacting their league commissioner. Any team that cancels a scheduled game will be charged a \$25.00 fee plus the applicable guaranteed referee fees assigned.

After the game has been cancelled the teams will need to follow the instructions found under Form #13 (Canceled Game Policy) in the Forms Section to reschedule the game.

Option #2- Any team which cannot play on the date scheduled can forfeit the game.

The team that forfeits the game will receive a 3-0 loss plus a fine of \$25.00 and is responsible for the all referee fees.

Intentional Forfeit

If a team does not show up for their scheduled posted game and has not notified the league Commissioner a minimum of 48 hours prior to the game, the game will be designated as an Intentional forfeit. That team will be assessed a \$50.00 fine. Their opponent will be reimbursed their referee fees.
