

FORFEITS & RESCHEDULED GAMES POLICY

COACHES DO NOT CONTACT YOUR OPPONENT DIRECTLY TO CANCEL OR RESCHEDULE ANY GAME UNTIL YOU HAVE CONTACTED YOUR LEAGUE COMMISSIONER FIRST.

Any team that cannot play a posted game has two options:

Option #1 – Teams can reschedule game for any weeknight provided you have a field. To reschedule a game as a morning double header; you must contact your league commissioner. All morning games must be scheduled in conjunction with existing league schedules; and must be assigned through the league commissioner.

If you and your opponent agree to reschedule the game; the team who was responsible for the request will be responsible for paying a rescheduling fee (see below for the cost) and possibly the referee fees for the game that was cancelled.

Rescheduling Fees: 7v7 game, the cost will be \$55.00

9v9 game, the cost will be \$60.00

11v11 game for U13/U14, the cost will be \$60.00

11v11 game for U15/U16/U17/U18, the cost will be \$60.00

If your program/club did not provide C.M.S.A. a field or fields to schedule games for the season, the charge will be deducted from your posted forfeit bond.

Option #2- Any team which cannot play on the date scheduled can forfeit the game and be assessed a 3-0 loss. The opponent will get a refund for their referee fees for the game at the end of the season.

The team that forfeits a game is responsible for the reimbursement of their opponent's game and referee fees listed below.

7v7 game, the cost will be \$94.00

9v9 game, the cost will be \$130.00

11v11 game for U13/U14, the cost will be \$155.00

11v11 game for U15/U16/U17/U18, the cost will be \$175.00

If your program/club did not provide C.M.S.A. a field or fields to schedule games for the season, the charge will be deducted from your posted forfeit bond.

Intentional Forfeit

If a team does not show up for their scheduled posted game and/or has not notified their league commissioner by a minimum of 48 hours prior to the scheduled game, the game will be designated an intentional forfeit. That team will be assessed all the referee fees applicable for that game (as listed above under Option #2); in addition to being assessed with a 3 to 0 loss in addition to being fined \$75. The opponent will be reimbursed their referee fees plus their league fees for this game at the end of the season.
