

TEAM PLACEMENT: A, B, C & RECREATION TRAVEL

CMSA will operate in a four (4) tier division allowing for a minimum allowing for minimum of six (6) teams in each competitive age level providing that team registration permits. We will then create four competitive levels of A, B, C and Recreation Travel as per the (Team Application). A/B combined divisions will be formed if there are less than 5 teams registered to play in the A division. The A/B division will have crossover games during the season. We will not combine the B & C teams unless we only have 3 C teams registered.

The four divisions are as follows:

A: Premier Divisions: For teams made up of experienced skilled players, formed through open try-outs.

A/B: Divisions: Will be formed if there are not enough, four (4) or less A teams that register to play A. This division will be made up of the A teams and the Best B teams available based on their past seasons record.

B: Challenge Division: For teams made up of a competitive mix of moderate to intermediate skilled players formed through open try-outs.

C: Classic Division: For entry level teams formed through open try-outs.

D. Recreation Travel: For teams who just want to play the game in a less competitive environment, but on a structured trave basis.

CMSA will review each team's past seasons record for final placement.

Teams which place themselves in the wrong division whether purposely or by mistake, and continually beat their opponents by a wide margin, will be eliminated from receiving awards from CMSA.

The 1st place team in each division will receive individual awards.
